Proposal "A" amends the City Charter to allow the City Council to adopt by ordinance the dollar limits above which competitive bidding is required for the purchase and sale of city property.

Proposal "B" amends the City Charter to allow the City Council to adopt by ordinance the dollar limits above which the City Manager must obtain City Council approval prior to undertaking purchases or sales of city property.

Both Proposal "A" and Proposal "B" were required to pass in order for either proposal to take effect.

Proposal "C" amends the City Charter to change the terms of office for Library Board members from five years to two years.
